Sterling Municipal Light Department (SMLD) SOLAR REBATE PROGRAM

- a) Applications will begin on **May 20, 2019** through July 31, 2020 or until funds are exhausted.
- b) The SMLD Solar Rebate Program will include a rebate of up to \$1.20/watt. The SMLD will contribute \$0.60/watt and the DOER will contribute \$0.60/watt. The SMLD will contribute \$10K towards this program in calendar year 2019. Future funding will be on a yearly basis.
- c) Projects that were authorized by the DOER that started or completed **prior to May 20, 2019** **will not** be eligible for the rebate program.
- d) Customer must contact the SMLD prior to the construction of PV arrays.
- e) System rebates from the SMLD will be capped at \$3,000 per system and up to 5KW (individual system can be up to 90% of the customers annual peak demand) maximum up to 10 KW or less but only the first 5KW will qualify for the rebate).
- f) System must be under 20% shading, facing between 90 and 270 degrees.
- g) Solar installations must be registered for Massachusetts Class 1 RECS (MMWEC will facilitate).
- h) Renewable Energy Credits (RECS) will be owned by SMLD and retired by SMLD for the life of the solar installations.
- i) The **Massachusetts Municipal Wholesale Electric Company (MMWEC)** will facilitate all transactions.
- j) **MMWEC** will handle application vetting, enrolment, rebate processing and payment to customers and reporting to DOER.
